The Denver Public Library building is a 1956 structure with a 540,000 square-foot addition designed by Michael Graves, who was also heavily involved in the furniture design. Of particular importance was finding a source that could incorporate end panels into any manufacturer's metal shelving solution for a unified design, as shown below.
